Promoter's Conditions, Percy Mason Memorial Meet Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th December 2016

1. The competition will be held under ASA laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming.
2. The Licence number for the meet is 3NW161509.
3. The competition will be held at Orford Jubilee Neighbourhood Hub, Jubilee Way, Orford, Warrington, Cheshire, WA2 8HE.
4. **Entries for this meet will be on a 'first come, first served' basis.** The Promoter reserves the right to close entries earlier than the stated date, if the meet is becoming over-subscribed.
5. The closing date for submitted entries is midnight on Monday 17th October 2016.
6. All ages are 'age on day' as of midnight 4th December 2016.
7. The pool is 25m 8- lane with anti-wave lane ropes and electronic timing.
8. Age groups for boys and girls are 9,10,11,12,13,14,15 and over.
9. Start times are as stated in the programme of events but may be subject to change. Any changes will be notified on the club website.
10. Over the top starts will be used and all events will be heat declared winners.
11. Entries and results for this meet will be held on computer and may be published before, during or after the meet. As required by the Data Protection Act 1998 permission to hold and use such personal data will be deemed to have been given by the submission of an entry.
12. Warm up times will be split at the Promoter's discretion. All clubs will be required to provide supervision during the warm up for their own swimmers.
13. Anybody wishing to use photography equipment must register at the payment desk where they will be issued with a pass which must be worn at all times.
14. Spectator admission will be £8 per day, under 16's will be admitted free of charge. Spectators only staying for 1 session will receive a £4 refund on surrender of the wristband which all spectators will be required to wear. A programme to cover the whole of the meet will cost £2. A maximum number of 250 programmes will be available. All heats/results will be available on Meet Mobile and may also be available via the Live Results link on the website home page on the day of the meet.
15. All results displayed on the electronic scoreboard are for indication only and may not be the official result.
16. Medals will be presented to the **top 6 winners in each age group.** Awards will also be presented to the top point scoring girl and boy and top visiting club.
17. **Entries** – will be accepted from any swimmer registered with an ASA affiliated club. The minimum age for entry will be 9 years as of midnight on 4th December 2016. There are no qualifying times, swimmers with no times may enter this meet. However, **all entries should have a coach's estimate for the purpose of seeding.** No swimmer should have exceeded or equalled the upper limit times as stated in the entry pack.
18. The Promoter reserves the right to restrict entries in the interests of safety, time constraints and to ensure the smooth running of the competition.
19. Where it becomes necessary to restrict the number of entries, the following criteria will be used
 - Priority will be given to swimmers who are accompanied by a visiting official. Names and qualifications of officials willing to attend must be provided at the time of entry to qualify for priority
 - Swimmers with fastest submitted times will take precedence in each age group

- The events chosen for restriction will be at the discretion of the Promoter and entries will be proportionate to each age group

20. Entries should be made using the Hy-Tek electronic entry file which can be downloaded from the website www.swimwarriors.org.uk.
 21. Paper entries will not be accepted due to the extra time and work this method of entry requires.
 22. Electronic entry fee will be £6 per event.

 24. **Entries will not be accepted until full payment is received. Entries should be paid for in full at the time of receipt of the electronic entry file by the Promoter. Payment not received within 5 days of receipt of the electronic entry file will result in the rejection of those entries.**
 25. Refunds will be given to those entries which are rejected based on the criteria in Point 18. Refunds will be available for collection in the form of a Club cheque on the day of the meet.
 26. Refunds will not be given for withdrawal of entries unless a medical certificate is received.
There will be no refunds for withdrawals made after the closing date.
 27. All times entered must be short course times, actual or converted. It is the responsibility of all competing clubs to ensure that entry times are accurate. Times may be randomly checked against ASA Rankings times.
 28. Withdrawals can only be made up to midnight on 2nd December. There will be no withdrawals allowed on the day. The meet will run with empty lanes.
 29. Competitors are responsible for presenting themselves to the marshals in good time for the event in which they are competing.
 30. All details of accepted/rejected entries will be posted on the club's website www.swimwarriors.org.uk.
 31. Coaches' passes will be available at the cost of £10 each to cover all sessions, with a maximum of 3 passes per club.
 32. All attending the meet must abide by rules of Livewire Centre Management.
 33. Any matter not covered by the Promoter Conditions will be at the discretion of the Promoter.
